

Process in the above entitled case is regretfully returned herein together with check in the amount of \$ 25.00 , for the reason or reasons designated below:

- () 1. Service of Process on a qualified foreign business corporation should be made on the Secretary of the Commonwealth through the Sheriff of Dauphin County, as required by Section 1011A of the Business Corporation Law.
- () 2. Process in an action instituted in the Federal Courts should be served on the Secretary of the Commonwealth by the Marshal of the Middle District of Pennsylvania.
- () 3. Process on a foreign corporation not qualified to do business in Pennsylvania, or on a Pennsylvania corporation which cannot be located, should be accompanied with properly authenticated copy of Petition and Order of Court thereon authorizing service to be made on the Secretary of the Commonwealth.
- () 4. The statutory fee is \$5.00 for each defendant to be served. Accordingly, check for \$ should accompany the process on its return to this office.
- () 5. Since service of process is being made on more than one defendant, certified or attested copy of the pleadings for each defendant should be submitted on whom service is being made.
- () 6. The pleadings must be attested or certified as a true copy.
- () 7. Process should be transmitted to this Department by REGISTERED or CERTIFIED MAIL RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED.
- () 8. The Secretary of the Commonwealth is without authority to act as statutory agent for the service of process in an action of this kind.

The Sheriff is responsible to make Service on this corporation. We do it through the Sheriff of Dauphin County or the Marshal of the Middle District when served at the office in person.




Deputy Sheriff Drum:
