WRIT OF EXECUTION

NOTICE

This paper is a Writ of Execution. It has been issued because there is a judgement against you. It may cause your property to be held or taken to pay for this judgement. You may have legal rights to prevent your property from being taken. A lawyer can advise you more specifically of these rights. If you wish to exercise your rights, you must act promptly.
