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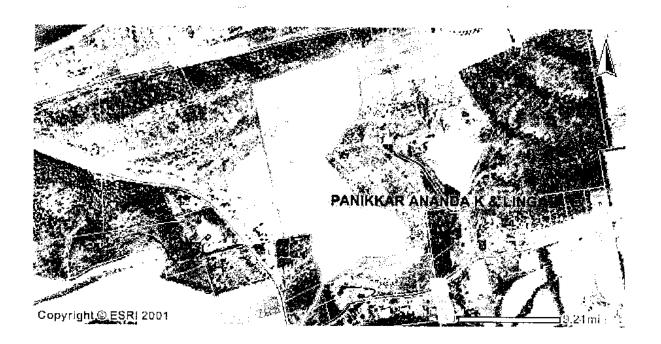

In the case of a default all sums paid by bidder will be considered forfeited, but will be applied against any damages recoverable. The defaulting bidder will be responsible for any attorney fees incurred by the Sheriff in connection with any action against the bidder in which the bidder is found liable for damages.
